


Flow: Initial Lens

- 1. Topography and eye analysis (type of condition)
- 2. Choose starting lens
- 3. Fluorescein in bowl of lens & insert
- 4. Rx over lens (retinoscopy)
- 5. Look at lens, make notes
- 6. Fluorescein OVER lens (superior conjunctiva), look for seepage

Flow: Follow Up (lens on eye 4+ hours prior to appt)

- 1. VA
- 2. ORx (look for bubbles or dense fogging first)
- 3. Slit lamp for lens fit
 - a. Mark down clearances, edges
 - b. Mark down any areas to look at with OCT
- 4. Fluorescein over lens, check for seepage
- 5. OCT and complete design on paper
- 6. Call in to lab any revisions
